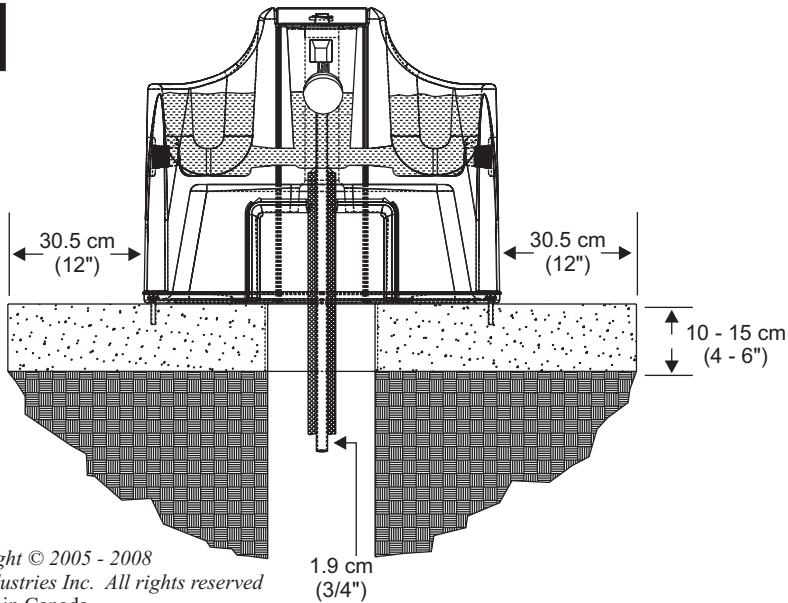

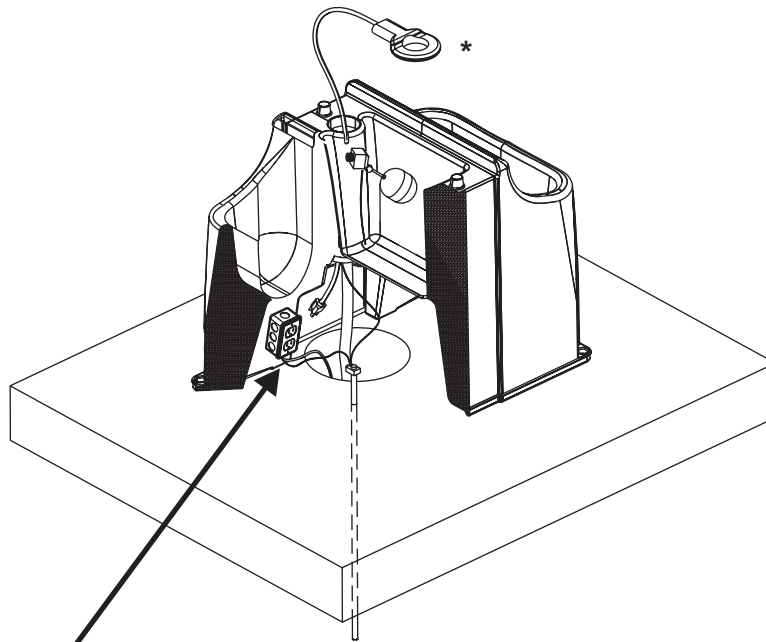

## Installation of the Model C-500 Submersible Heater

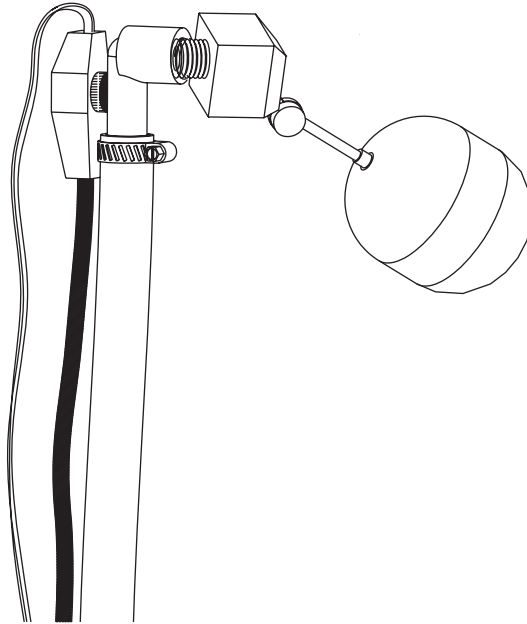

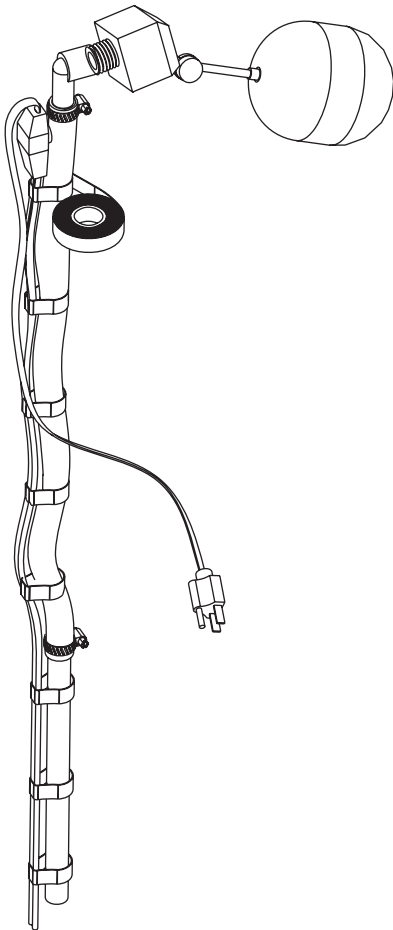

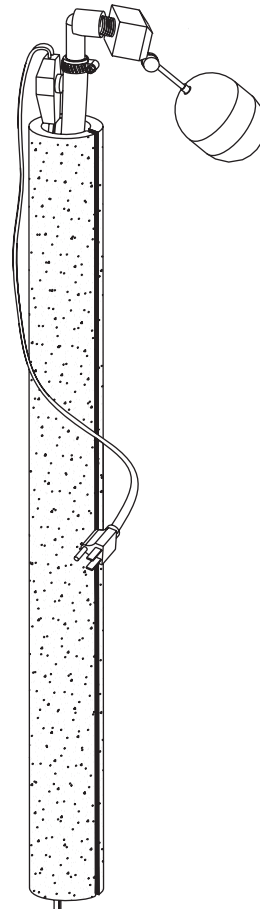
